		Snow Shovel & Ice Scraper A must have in the winter season
		<b>Sand</b> Use to create traction in the wheels on slippery surfaces
		<b>Tire Pressure Gauge</b> Tires often loose pressure in cold weather
		<b>Tire Sealant</b> Temporary fix for those small flat tires
		Jumper Cables Always keep this in your car
		<b>Road Flares or Reflective Triangles</b> Useful for cars on the road and to sign for assistance
		Flashlight or Headlight Consider a hand-cranked over battery operated
		Tire, Jack & Lug Wrench Always keep this in your car
		<b>Tow Strap</b> Very helpful to have in case the car is stuck
		First Aid Kit Always keep this in your car
		Pocket Multi-Tool Always keep this in your car
		<b>Battery-Powered Weather Radio</b> Stay up-to-date on weather changes
		<b>Bottled Water</b> Smaller bottles are easier to thaw out if necessary
		<b>Snacks</b> Avoid snack with short expiration dates
		<b>Hand Warmers and Blankets</b> Very useful if caught in cold weather for long periods
		<b>Extra Jackets, Winter Hats, and Gloves</b> Avoid wearing wet/damp clothing
		Portable Power Brick Charge cell phones and other electronic devices
